**Footnotes**

SATELLITE BEACH stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. HERMAN'S SOLDIER was never far back, raced inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. EXPOSED IMAGE was unhurried early, raced inside on the last turn then angled outward at the 1/4 pole and rallied mildly in the lane. PALCHAMP vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn, then weakened late. CRIMSON THUNDER pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn then faded. BEST LITE vied for the lead from the inside through the last turn, then faltered late. BATTLE MOUNTAIN was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then failed to sustain a bid. UNUSUAL JUSTIN raced three wide on the last turn then failed to menace. WESTERN MYSTERY saved ground but was not a threat. CITY SKY was through early and outrun.
