GLOBAL RISK vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch while under steady encouragement. SAND DEVIL pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. FIDDLER'S REDDEMON stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, then angled out late and gave way. BRANDON LUIS CARLO vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the drive. FINANCIAL LEGACY vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faded in the drive. MR GUES was close up early, raced along the four path on the turn then faltered. MERTSWISH lacked speed, raced inside on the turn and was never a factor. CHARLIEOATRICKSTER lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and was outrun. GREAT GATOR showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn, then tired and was eased to the wire.
