**Footnotes**

RAPID REDUX came in while showing speed from the gate, stayed out from the rail around the turn, drew out in early stretch and proved best under mild urging. Following an objection by Vaz, RAPID REDUX was disqualified and placed eighth. SNOW HILL was shuffled back at the break, stayed well out from the rail around the turn then made a late run outside. BOBBY TWO PIECES fell back early, stayed inside around the turn, angled out in the lane and finished fastest. RIGHT FLANKER was in tight after the break, raced two wide into the stretch and gained mildly. CASE NOTES stayed outside and lacked a rally. PRINCE OF BELAIR angled to the inside while not far back on the turn then weakened. H F MANIX was steadied in tight after the break, stayed out from the rail and failed to menace. CALIFORNIA COOL was steadied and came in after the break, was sent up between horses early to press the leader then tired. THAT BOY showed speed outside into the turn then stopped.
