Footnotes

DR. BALIN stalked two wide, took over in early stretch, moved clear into the final sixteenth and held. GRAZIANO was unhurried inside, began a run after a half, came out three wide for room on the final turn then closed a gap from the outside in the final yards. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE was unhurried outside, came out wide on the final turn and lacked a strong closing. SEVENISTHENUMBER made the way from the inside to the stretch then weakened. SARAS MOST WANTED steadied in tight between horses nearing the backstretch and again on the backstretch then continued evenly. INCISIVE STRIKE was slow to settle, raced wide around the final turn and found best stride too late. FAVORITE CARD was no factor. J D'S FIRECRACKER was outrun. CHICANE had position three wide to the far turn then stopped.
