MISS LONGEVITY was unhurried while saving ground, angled out in early stretch while rallying and drove clear through the final sixteenth. JUDGE BEAUTIFUL held a clear lead along the rail then weakened. POET'S LADY moved up outside after a quarter, drew closer on the final turn then flattened out in the lane. TURN THE CARD BABY was no factor. TURK'S LASSIE was outrun. RISINGALMA chased early then stopped.
