PRETTY BOY FOREST set the pace from the start, drew clear on the turn and finished under urging. MARQ OF LOVE was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. POWER SWEEP was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then weakened in the final yards. ROYAL STARE raced along the two path through the turn but lacked a rally. ALCHOLIDAY stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then faded late. EXCEL lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn, and showed little. FINAL KNOCKOUT saved ground and was outrun.
