PRIZE WINNER was unhurried, raced two wide around the final turn, angled to the rail in early stretch for room and was up late. SECRET LONGING was unhurried, began a run outside on the backstretch, was caught well out into the track while moving to command before six furlongs, drew clear in early stretch but couldn't last. NEO'S GRAND FINALE moved outside the early leader on the backstretch, remained prominent to the stretch then weakened. QUEEN'S RULE came out from the rail on the backstretch and continued evenly. EMPRESS HATSHEPSUT wasn't far back inside early, bobbed in early stretch and flattened out. JAGGERMAMA stayed out from the rail while making the pace for about six furlongs then tired. GOSHEN HAWK was finished early.
