OUR ROCKET MON stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn, then drew clear late and finished under urging. NEXT PAGE pressed the pace from the two path, gained the advantage on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. PLYMOUTH SQUARE was never far back, raced inside on the second turn then angled outward but lacked a late response. LEFT FOOT SLEWIE set the pace from then start, raced along the inside on the last turn and was headed then faded in the drive. FRESHMAN FORUM was unhurried early, raced two wide on the far turn then showed little. ROLL DEM BONES was close up early and saved ground through the far turn, then flattened out late. MR PRIME MINISTER saved ground but trailed throughout.
