Footnotes

PIONEER ZEPHYR wasn't far back along the rail into the stretch, swung out leaving the turn then closed steadily and was along in time. TOOT Z ROLL was unhurried, raced three wide around the turn then rallied outside and missed. TUFF TRI pressed two wide moved clear in early stretch then gave way late. PERFECT SHADOW was fractious in the gate then was unprepared for the break, was unhurried, raced wide around the turn and finished with good energy outside. SUPER QUEEN was slow early, stayed out from the rail around the turn and made up ground too late. ABONIA stayed inside and lacked a significant closing. FIRST IN FASHION wasn't far back three wide to the stretch then bore out and tired. CAROL SNUCK IN moved clear from the outside midway on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn then tired in the drive. MS. ALIAS SMITH tired two wide.
