Footnotes

BALTIMORE NATIVE was unhurried early, saved ground throughout, rallied late then drew off under urging. PREACHER'S KID was rushed to the lead from the start then set the pace while saving ground, was headed on the far turn then drew off but was outfinished in the final yards. OMRICON was slow early, raced four wide on the second turn then rallied mildly in the lane. RAISE THE CODE prompted the pace from along the inside through the second turn then weakened late. PIONEER PARTNER pressed the pace from the two path, reached contention on the last turn then faded. WAY YONDER raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. BATTLE MOUNTAIN was close up early, raced inside on the last turn then faltered. SIR PRIZE U saved ground while trailing the field.
