PRICELESS VIEW was content to lag badly inside, circled into the stretch while rallying and quickly drew clear past midstretch. PATRICK N DYLAN had position outside, moved four wide to command midway on the turn, edged clear after five furlongs but was no match. GRILLER pressed inside into the turn, fell back, came well out from the rail nearing the stretch and continued evenly. PARK RULES had position three wide between horses to the stretch then weakened. TOMBALL made the pace two wide into the turn then tired in the drive. FRONT MAN wasn't far back inside early, came out on the turn then tired. PRIVATE MARQUE moved up between horses following a slow break, angled to the inside on the turn and tired. YOU HAVE NO IDEA wasn't far back to the stretch while racing well out from the rail and stopped.
