Footnotes

ASK OMMADON was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn, then closed ground fast to be up in time while under urging. THREE POINT TICKET pressed the pace from the two path from the start, reached contention on the far turn then was outfinished in the final strides. AZICHARMYOU stalked the pace early, raced along the inside on the far turn then angled to the outside and gained a lead in the stretch but gave way late. JULES CAESAR vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then faded late. GATES BLUFF prompted the early pace, saved ground, then was outrun on the far turn. SAVATRON set the early pace then pulled up on the backstretch.
