EVEN FRISKY was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then reached contention in mid stretch and drew clear while under urging. CASANOVA JACK was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. FAVORITE CARD was void of early speed, raced along the inside through the turn, then found his best stride late. AMBROSE LIGHT vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path through the turn, then gave way after a long drive. LOVE YOU TOO pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. SPIKEAVELLIAN vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faltered late. JANUARY GENT lacked speed, raced three wide through the turn and was never a threat. BLIND BLUFF was through early, raced two wide on the turn and was outrun.
