CHEROKEE EMPIRE stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, reached contention in the stretch and prevailed at the wire. GOLDEN ACCOUNT pressed the pace from the three path on the turn, reached contention in the stretch then entered into a long drive and just missed. GO SWISH was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and advanced steadily throughout. PENNSYLVANIAEXPRESS was close up early, raced four wide on the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. BACK ALLEY TALES was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then rallied mildly late. COLLEGE GRAD set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground on the turn, then faltered late. BIG M J pressed the early pace, saved ground on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. FAVORITE CARD was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. LITTLE PEP raced along the inside on the turn and was not a factor. GORDONRYAN showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. FREE COUNTRY lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and showed little. BANDIDOS YANQUIS lacked speed, raced along the inside on the turn and was outrun.
