SMALLTOWNMAN was unhurried, rallied wide around the final turn, moved clear before a mile and was kept to urging. RASCAL FLATTER moved up inside on the backstretch, lacked room behind the leader around the final turn, vied along the rail into the final furlong but was no match for the winner. EXTREME DREAM bobbled leaving the gate then pressed the early leader inside, opened a short lead in early stretch then weakened. TIZ RELEVANT moved three wide to vie on the final turn then weakened in the drive. TWO TAVERNS was slow to settle, made a run along the rail around the final turn to get closer in early stretch then tired. MENIFEE SIX was outrun. GOOD NEWS BILLY made the pace two wide to the stretch then tired. H W GOODIE tired inside.
