WESTERN FAULT stalked the early leader from the three path, moved clear in early stretch then widened. KALIA was unhurried after a slow break, raced wide between rivals into the stretch and gained to the end. COMING UP ROSES fell back inside entering the turn then continued evenly. SUPER QUEEN lagged, swung widest into the stretch and gained late. VICTORIA ALEXES stayed out from the rail while making the pace to the stretch then weakened. SALISHAN was outrun inside. PATTON'S STAR wasn't far back early while out from the rail then tired.
