Footnotes

SATELLITE BEACH stalked the pace from the two path through the last turn, then drew clear and finished under urging. AWESOME RUBIANO pressed the pace from the inside through the far turn, made a late bid and finished second best. DESERT MUSIC was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. TAXWISE set the pace from the start, saved ground through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. CAUNOTAUCARIUS was void of early speed, raced inside on the second turn and was not a threat. KING MIDAS lacked speed, raced two wide on the final turn, then passed tiring rivals. LATE IN THE DAY was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then faded in the stretch. CARD PLAYER prompted the early pace, raced three wide through the far turn then faltered. RARE BREED lacked speed and was outrun.
