**Footnotes**

SEATTLE APPEAL was void of early speed, raced four wide at the top of the stretch, rallied from the outside and was up in the final strides. RISINGALMA vied for the lead from along the inside, was pressured throughout and gave way. TWO TONE stalked the pace from along the inside, then angled out to the three path to reach contention at the 1/4 pole, then weakened in the final yards. PLUVIAL raced along the inside to the far turn and failed to menace. LADY COUNSELOR vied for the lead from the start, raced along the three path to the far turn, then faded on that turn. DANA'S DEVIL lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn and showed little. CLASSIC ZIPPER was close up and four wide on the first turn, lacked a rally and was outrun. FORTUNATE GIRL was void of early speed, raced four wide at the top of the stretch, began a rally then pulled up lame in mid stretch.
