GATTOPARDO vied for the lead from the two path, then drew clear on the turn and held well at the wire while under urging. CASH MCCOOL was never far back, raced three wide through the turn, then closed the gap but hung in the final yards. GALLIGAN ROAD was close up early, raced inside through the turn, then lacked a late response. SPRIDAL was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn, then made a mild bid late. I AM THE KING stumbled at the start, raced three wide on the turn, then was not a threat. AFRICAN KING vied for the early lead, raced inside on the turn, then flattened out late.
