PURPLE PEGASUS broke slowly then was unhurried, raced two wide between horses around the turn, edged out for the drive and quickly ran clear through late stretch. PERCY JACKSON was unhurried inside, angled out through the lane and finished gamely. PARTYGUID advanced outside on the backstretch, continued to gain while wide around the turn but flattened out in the lane. LAD OF LAMAR wasn't far back early, came out into the three path while moving on the turn, drew clear in early stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth then tired. TWO STEP TOMMY wasn't far back outside early, fell back three wide on the turn and continued evenly. BRAVEHEART BUZZ moved up inside the early leader midway on the backstretch and was finished soon after. STORMIN LEX sped to the front at once, made the pace out from the rail to the stretch then stopped and was eased up late. MADD SKILZ fell far back.
