STORMY MONSE angled to the inside while unhurried early, steadied in tight entering the turn, came out two wide between rivals, steadied again behind the leader approaching the stretch, moved to the front once clear and drew out under urging. GYPSY TRAVELER was unhurried following a slow break, stayed inside around the turn then angled out through the lane and gained to the end. CHRISI'S MOGLIE moved to a short lead from between rivals after going a furlong, stayed out from the rail once clear on the turn then weakened. NO MORE BUBBLES pressed inside the early leader to the turn, fell back and continued evenly. TEN IS MAGIC lagged inside to the stretch then came out between rivals with a belated run. LADY HAYA wasn't far back outside, raced four wide around the turn and weakened. ASHALAH was outrun. PLUPERFECT raced three wide with the pace into the turn then tired in the lane.
