BIG TIME BLING moved to a clear lead before going a furlong, stayed close to the inside and faltered. PATTIE THIEF wasn't far back along the rail into the stretch, angled out and weakened. SOCIALISTA raced two wide between rivals around the turn and lacked a closing. BYE BYE FOR NOW tired inside. DEAR CLARISE was outrun inside. NEW YEAR'S BABY was outrun. VANAEMA was no factor. RIVER CHESNUT was outrun. JAZZY JENNA showed speed briefly. SKIMMIN N SWIMMIN stopped.
