SUGAH SWEET was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn then angled outward and rallied in the drive and drew off late. PINK AND BLACK vied for the lead from the two path, drew clear on the far turn, then was outfinished late. ALANA'S DREAM was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then closed ground willingly from the outside. SIGN OF HOPE was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. REAL HOPE was outrun early, raced two wide on the far turn, then found her best stride late. PRINCESS OF HEARTS vied for the lead from the inside then weakened on the far turn. CHISPA was void of early speed, raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. ROSES FOR TARA was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn and faltered then was outdistanced. SOLEDAD'S COURT raced inside and was through early then outdistanced.
