DEFERLONG broke sharply, then set the pace with a clear lead while saving ground throughout and finished under urging. PURIM KATAN was never far back, raced four wide on the turn then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. DOCTOR DANGER stumbled at the start, then raced three wide on the turn and closed ground willingly from the outside. STAR ISABELLA pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn then weakened in the stretch. RAIL ROADIE stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then faded in the lane. FIVE STAR SUCCESS raced two wide on the turn but failed to menace. WITT'S ROAD lacked speed, raced along the inside on the turn and was not a factor. CATNIP LOUISE trailed to mid stretch, saved ground on the turn and was never a threat. WITT'S BLING BLING raced two wide on the turn, then showed little and was outrun.
