PLEASEANDTHANKYOU vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, entered into a long drive then gave way in the final yards. FAMILY FACTS was close up from the start, raced three wide on the turn and evenly throughout. SUNSHINE BROTHER was slow early, raced inside on the turn, then rallied mildly late. MARCY'S WOODS was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a rally. BIBBLESMAN raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. GRAND OLD GAME stumbled at the start, saved ground through the turn then passed one late. TOWN SQUARED vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faltered in the stretch and was outrun.
