LUMEN was unhurried two wide, came out wide for room nearing the stretch while rallying, bid outside in midstretch and prevailed. WHITE BALANCE was unhurried inside, steadied while lacking room on the final turn, came out between horses for the drive, was in tight entering the final furlong, split horses to loom a threat inside the winner in midstretch but wasn't enough. REFINED DESIGN was slow early, made a run along the rail into the stretch to loom a threat but hung. FERBER was unhurried early then made up ground between horses through the lane. SLIEVENAMON wasn't far back outside, began a wide run into the far turn, vied before three quarters then flattened out. I'M SURE wasn't far back while out from the rail but lacked a rally. LITESCAMERACTION weakened inside. ABBALICIOUS had position three wide, bid on the final turn then flattened out. HORN BROOK was unhurried early then lacked room on the final turn. PRIVATE TOUCH was outrun. PASCO GETTLE stopped. OMERTA stayed out from the inside while making the way into the far turn then stopped and was eased up late.
