BOB'S RETIRED was slow to settle, rallied three wide around the final turn and slowly closed a gap through late stretch. PROUD EDITION lagged early then made a run along the rail around the final turn and through the stretch. COMIC BOOK was slow to settle, stayed outside and made up some ground. CARRIZO SPRINGS wasn't far back inside early, came out on the final turn then tired. YOST ROAD was outrun. PETE SHURE stopped. TUNDRA ROAD was no factor. LAW JUDGE was outrun. JEREMIAH'S STORY pressed the winner to the far turn then stopped.
