Footnotes

U BOAT ALLEY showed speed from the outset, stayed out from the rail once clear on the turn and was put to strong urging. PROPHETABLE PRINCE wasn't far back while lacking room nearing the turn and again nearing the stretch, angled out between horses, drew closer in early stretch then flattened out. TEA TOTT was unhurried while not far back, raced two wide around the turn and lacked a strong closing. TRUE TO THE LADIES had position three wide to the stretch then tired. BRANDAL came well out from the rail and failed to menace. BATTLEGROUND was outrun after a slow break. DUTY FIRST moved to the front before going a furlong, stayed inside and stopped. GUS THE FIREFLY made a mild run four wide on the turn then was eased up through the stretch.
