Footnotes

DILATORY stalked the pace and reached contention early, raced two wide through the second turn, then drew off in the stretch while under mild encouragement. PADRE ED was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn then angled outward and made a late bid but was no match for the winner. H W GOODIE was close up early, contended on the backstretch then saved ground through the second turn and weakened late. STRONGEST was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. TETON SUN lacked speed, raced along the two path on the last turn then moved to the rail in the stretch but showed little. FRENCH LIEUTENANT vied for the lead from the inside through the second turn, then faltered in the stretch. RUNAWAY BEN vied for the early lead from along the inside, then flattened out on the last turn and was outdistanced.
