JAZZ HON was never far back, raced four wide through the turn then rallied from the outside and prevailed while under urging. NEXT set the pace from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then was outfinished in the final strides. DUSTY BEAU pressed the pace from the two path and reached contention on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. CHIMAYO VALLEY prompted the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then faded late. OUR CORN was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. STARSHIP BOY raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. FLYING TOMATO raced along the two path on the turn and trailed throughout.
