LADY OF THE PRESS enjoyed a ground saving trip, could not threaten the winner but was well clear of the rest of the field. BLACK TIE BOOGIE pressed the pace to six furlongs then gave way. HAPPY APPLE was allowed to settle, moved out for the stretch run, lacked the needed response. TWENTY ONE KISSES made a run to contention midway through the race and flattened out. JANUARY ANGEL was close up to the far turn, tired badly. BOLDLY BEAUTIFUL raced four wide on the first turn, was always far back.
