BRUSHWITHTHEDEVIL showed speed outside, stayed out from the inside once clear on the turn and widened under urging. ACADEMY RUN was never far back, moved up on the turn while racing well out from the rail then flattened out in the lane while second best. DELAWARE RIVER was unhurried, raced three wide around the turn and weakened. NORJAC stumbled badly leaving the gate then lagged inside and passed tired ones. SYLVIA'S FORTE steadied while lacking room behind the leaders nearing the end of the backstretch and into the turn then flattened out. COCO POINT showed speed inside to the turn then stopped.
