WICKED DREAMS was never far back, raced two wide on the last turn, then drew clear late and finished handily. EARNEST HOPE was close up and along the inside, then drew clear on the second turn but gave way in the stretch. LISTENTOTHEJUNKMAN was slow early, raced along the four path on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. CHANGE FOR GOLD was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid late and tired in the final yards. RUMMY vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the last turn, then lacked a late response. FAST FLING lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and showed little throughout. MERCURIO vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside on the second turn then flattened out. PAXON vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the last turn then faltered and was outdistanced. PLEASANT CROWN was close up early, raced along the inside and was through after half and outdistanced.
