SMOKIN THINGS was in a bit tight along the rail entering the turn, came out two wide between horses on the turn then took over in midstretch. MORADOR LLERS (ARG) wasn't far back outside, rallied widest around the turn, took over in early stretch then faltered. MY BEST PAL RED broke sharply to make the early pace inside and continued gamely once displaced. QUIET THANKS showed speed outside, opened a clear lead into the turn, remained out from the inside and weakened. PAPALEO was caught in tight between horses nearing the end of the backstretch and into the turn, came out three wide then weakened. KALEIDOSTAR was caught in tight between horses nearing the end of the backstretch and into the turn, angled out then tired. BEAT YOUR BLUFF bore out on the turn while outrun. J D'S FIRECRACKER angled in and failed to menace.
