TETON PASS stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, gained command in the stretch then just lasted while under urging. COOL PUNCH vied for the lead from the four path on the turn, dropped back in the stretch then came again late and just missed. SYLVIA'S FORTE was close up and two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid in the lane. DON SEIS was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. TOMBALL vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then tired in the drive. PATRICK N DYLAN raced inside on the turn but failed to menace. USMC SEMPER FI raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. LIL CHA CHING vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then faltered in the drive and was outrun.
