**Footnotes**

LAST INDIAN was unhurried early, raced two wide through the far turn and closed fast drawing clear while under urging. TOP OF THE TREE was never far back, raced four wide on the second turn, then rallied late to be second best. WILMETTE was close up early, reached contention on the backstretch, the raced inside on the far turn and weakened late. LOVELY AS EVER was slow early, raced two wide on the second turn, then found her best stride late. THERE'S NO DISPUTE vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn then faded. ELFRIEDE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn, then was not a threat. BREAK FAST TIFFANY vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the last turn then flattered. HERO'S CALL was close up early, raced inside on the second turn, then faded in the stretch. COAL VALLEY lacked speed and showed little. CLOSE THE DEAL was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn, then flattened out in the lane.
