DON'T TELL THE MRS showed speed from the outset, took over from the outside nearing the turn, drew clear entering the stretch and was under brisk urging to the end. KAZ CITY was slow to settle, moved up three wide on the turn then continued evenly through the lane. POST MASTER stayed inside in an even effort. ANGEL CITY was slow to settle, raced three wide around the turn and made a late run outside. WESTERN PIRATE stayed close early while out from the rail then tired. HE CAN STEP was hustled to the front from the gate, stayed inside and stopped. DYNAMIC ONE showed speed outside to the stretch then stopped. ROBIDOUX was outrun after a slow break. MORE GRAVY was outrun. LITTLE LIGHTNING was finished early.
