Footnotes

NO BRAKES was content to lag, rallied well out into the track around the final turn then ran clear under urging from the outside. BOOM DE YA DA was never far back, moved three wide to command midway on the final turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the lane. NO INFLATION moved clear from the outside entering the first turn, angled to the inside then tired in the lane. TAP ATTACK was slow early then made a late run outside. QUILLIAN moved to press the early leader while between horses then tired in the lane. KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART wasn't far back two wide then tired. AMABILIS was outrun. MISSION GAP wasn't far back inside for about a half then stopped and lost contact.
