CELESTIAL LADY stalked the pace from the start, raced three wide and reached contention on the second turn, then drew off late while under urging. NICKEL C pressed the pace from the two path early, reached contention on the last turn, then gave way late. MISSTERIA was never far back, raced two wide on the far turn and made a late bid. POWERFUL PRESENCE was unhurried early, raced three wide on the final turn, then found her best stride late. HER LAST COGNAC was outrun through the last turn while saving ground, then passed tiring rivals. KEYSTONE DANCER raced four wide on the last turn and evenly throughout. IMATIGRESSTOO lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn and showed little. DON'T PUSH IT set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while racing along the rail to the far turn, then flattened out.
