**Footnotes**

RARE RAVEN was unhurried early, raced two wide around the turn, angled outside in early stretch then ran clear from the outside at the end. TOOT Z ROLL settled, raced two wide around the turn, vied inside the winner in deep stretch but wasn't enough. BIG BOX pressed the early leader from the outside, opened a clear lead in early stretch, remained clear to late stretch then gave way. GINAGAIN wasn't far back inside, came out between rivals in the lane but lacked the needed late response. BARCAZA lagged early then made a late run between rivals. SUPER QUEEN was slow to settle while three wide then gained mildly. LEMON DROP BLONDES stayed out from the rail and tired. DREAMING OF A WIN broke sharply to make the early pace, angled to the rail and tired. RUNFAST was outrun following a slow break.
