ABETTER RETURN was slow to settle, stayed inside and made up some ground. THREE IN THE BAG stayed out from the rail in an even effort. CHARMING KISSES was slow to find best stride. TOP SEED stayed inside and lacked a rally. FUERTE wasn't far back outside early then tired. SHONE was no factor. CAPRIDGE stayed out from the inside while close up into the turn then stopped. WANDER TIME broke in the air then was outrun. SLEW OF SMOKE was outrun.
