BLUE RIGHT BY vied for the lead from the two path through the last turn, entered into a long drive then drew clear in the stretch while under urging. LITTLE PEP vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the far turn, then dueled in the lane and gave way late. TONY'S BACK was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then closed ground willingly from the outside. NEW REVOLUTION pressed the pace from along the inside through the far turn, then weakened in the stretch. COFFEE BREAK was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn, then faded in the stretch. CAPE GIRARDEAU lacked speed, raced inside on the second turn then angled outward approaching the stretch but showed little. ITZA PURRFECT RIDE raced three wide on the last turn and failed to menace. FLYBIRD was close up early, raced inside on the second turn and flattened out.
