MOE LARRY CURLY vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then drew off in the stretch and finished under steady encouragement. MUDGIES LAST GEM stalked the pace from the start, raced along the four path on the turn and reached contention at the 1/4 pole, then was no match for the winner in the final yards. EL TEQUILA vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the drive. POP SEEKER was close up early, raced two wide on the turn then made a mild bid late. OPORTUNO pressed the early pace, raced along the two path on the turn then tired in the stretch. WISE THINKING vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the drive. BIG CUP OF SOUP was slow early, raced inside on the turn and was never a threat. DARK ALLEY showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn and was not a factor. IS NOT showed early speed, raced along the four path on the turn then faltered in the stretch. NINE IRON also showed early speed, raced inside on the turn then flattened out in the lane. THE LAST BABY lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and was outrun.
