CALL FIRST stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, then moved outward and reached contention in mid stretch then drew clear late while under urging. DOROTHY'S DIAMOND vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide on the turn, was engaged in a long drive then gave way late. ONE DIEGO vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. BRODY BOY was close up early, raced two wide on the turn then angled outward but lacked a rally late. MCKAYLA'S WISH showed early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then had nothing late. QUAD'S DOUBLE vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faded in the drive. COME ON OVER had brief speed, raced along the inside on the turn and showed little. PROWERS COUNTY showed early speed, raced three wide on the turn then was outrun late.
