BEN'S CAT stalked the pace from along the two path through the turn, then rallied in the stretch and was up in the final strides. IMMORTAL EYES pressed the pace early, raced three wide on the turn, the drew off in the stretch but was caught at the wire. POSEIDON'S WARRIOR prompted the pace from the start, raced four wide through the turn, then finished well. IL VILLANO stumbled at the start, raced four wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. BRAULIO was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn, then found his best stride late. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then failed to menace. SLOANE RANGER showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn then gave way. PHILLY BOUND vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faltered in the stretch. MEGA RUSH vied for the early lead, raced along the inside through the turn, then flattened out late.
