MY DREAM CATCHER vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under urging. TRUMATCH was close up and three wide on through the turn, then angled outward and made a late bid to be second best. ROCK N HEART was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. BRAVACCIO pressed the early pace from along the inside into the turn, then failed to sustain his bid. RED RIVER TOCCET was slow early, raced four wide on the turn and made a mild bid in the stretch. KALAS vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. MY DIGGER lacked speed, saved ground on the turn and showed little throughout. OSISKO vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faltered late and was outrun.
