PRIVATELY PROMISED stalked the pace from the two path, reached contention on the turn and drew clear in the stretch then just lasted while under urging. SPARK THE FUSE was never far back, raced along the four path on the turn, then closed ground willingly and just missed. HIM HAPPY was slow early, raced four wide on the turn, then rallied in the stretch. FANATIC HOPE set the pace from the start with a clear lead, saved ground on the turn then was headed and faded in the stretch. IT'S ALL OVER pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. BORN A HERO raced along the inside on the turn, then lacked a rally and failed to menace. JO ANN'S BULLET was close up early, raced three wide on the turn and was through after a half. WHEATON'S WISH lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and showed little throughout. COTTON GEORGE lacked speed, saved ground on the turn then was outrun.
