RAPID RAMPAGE broke sharply, stalked the pace from the two path and was well rated then drew off on the far turn and finished under urging. MEATBEAU was close up and raced two wide through the far turn and evenly to finish second best. ECLIPTICALS T BIRD was unhurried early, saved ground on the far turn, then rallied mildly late. QUIET MUSIC was never far back, raced three wide on the last turn, then weakened in the stretch. RIDLEY CREEK ROAD pressed the pace from the start, raced inside on the second turn, then faded in the stretch. ESSON set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground then gave way on the far turn. WEEKEND SECRET lacked any speed, saved ground on the second turn and trailed throughout.
