SLEEPING TIGER was never far back, raced along the inside through the turn, then angled outward and rallied late to be up in the final strides. CHEROKEE CARL was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then angled to the outside and closed fast just missing. CORVINO vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way late. H W GOODIE was close up and inside through the turn but lacked a rally. RUNFORHONOR raced three wide on the turn and made a mild bid late. AGONISTIC was close up and two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. LASTCALLFORDISCO was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then was not a threat. STORM OF CASIA vied for the lead from the two path through the turn then faltered. NORMAN ASBJORNSON raced five wide on the turn and failed to menace. BUST YER BUBBLE pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then flattened out in the lane. SHETAN raced four wide on the turn, then was outrun in the stretch.
