ELLENBERGER PARK was never far back, raced two wide on the last turn, then rallied late and drew clear while under urging. ALINA'S LAD set the pace from the start, saved ground through the last turn with a clear lead, then was outfinished in the final yards. SPUNK pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, then weakened late. DAVID K was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, then found his best stride late. EVENING CONCERTO was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. DOMESTIC AFFAIR prompted the early pace, raced four wide on the last turn, then faded late. IKAN stalked the early pace, raced along the inside on the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. BRUCE ALLEY was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then gave way in the stretch. FIRST NITE pressed the pace from the three path into the last turn then tired. CANAL STREET was close up early, raced four wide on the last turn, then was through after a half and outrun.
